2020

- WITHDRAWAL AGREEMENT: NORTHERN IRELAND PROTOCOL WHICH WILL REMAIN AN SPS ENCLAVE « UE »
- KEEPING CURRENT RULES FOR INTRA-EU TRADE DURING THE TRANSITION PHASE
- JULY : PUBLICATION OF BORDER OPERATING MODEL (BOM – version1)
- OCTOBER : PUBLICATION OF BORDER OPERATING MODEL (BOM – version 2)
- END 2020 : PUBLICATION OF 50 STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS (sanitary regulations) and certificate models

2021

- T1 : PRENOTIFICATION and CERTIFICATION for « HIGH RISKS » and « HIGH PRIORITY » PRODUCTS



2.Imports from GB

Imports into the EU of horses from the GB

DA 2020/692 on entry into the EU of animals will apply as for any other third country

Identification, blood tests and quarantine



- Horses are identified prior to being dispatched from the establishment of origin at least by one of the following methods (Art 21 DA 2020/692):
 - an injectable transponder or ear tag,
 - in the case of equine animals **other than those intended for slaughter**, an identification document, issued at the latest at the time of certification for entry into the Union
 - Horse passport for **registered equines**
 - All other equines : a government –issued supplementary travel ID
- a health certificate is needed (new models will apply as of October 2021 provided they are issued before end of August- IA 2021/403)
- Health requirements (from the 21st of April)
 - UK is currently in the sanitary group A
 - Requirements as regards the residency periods (DA 2020/692, Annex III)
 - Diseases for which specific requirements are required : equine infectious anaemia

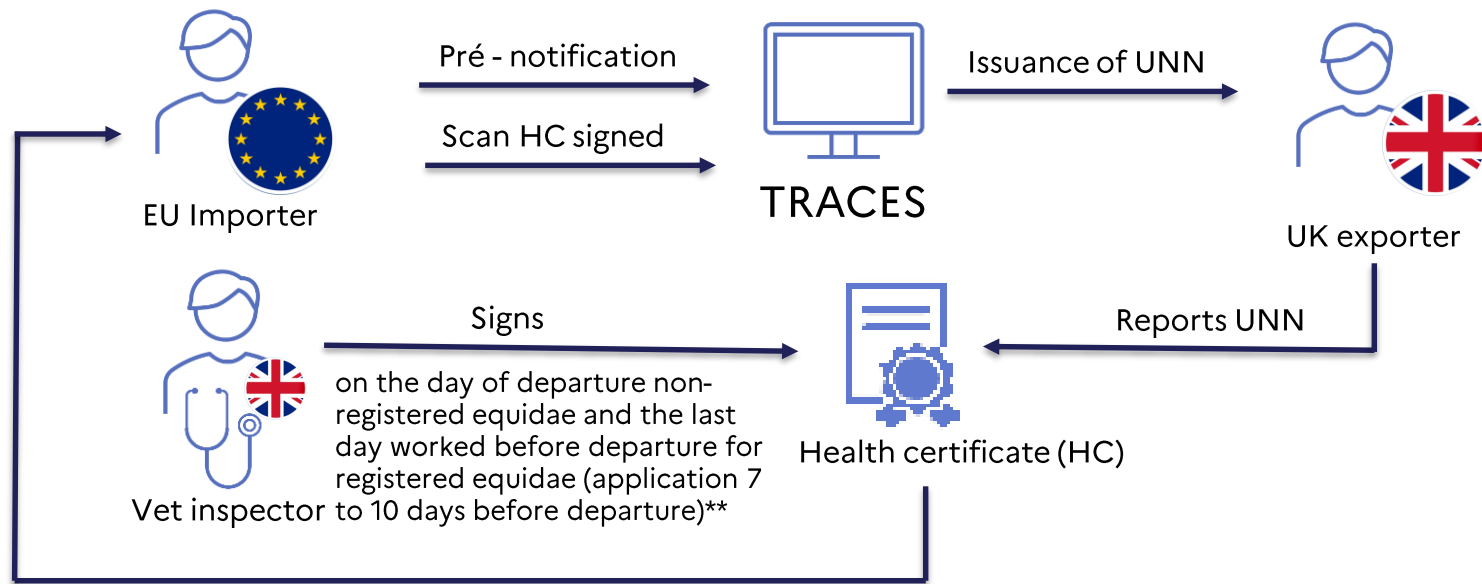

From 1st 2021 :

Entry of equidae only in Border Control Point (BCP) with documentary, identity and physical checks on the basis of a risk analysis

According to GB import, temporary admission and re-entry conditions based on old EU legislation (prior to 2018/659)

Identification, blood tests and quarantine



Identification

- Identified equidae

- **Registered equidae** (UE approved studbook or national branch of an international organization for sport or competition purposes)

Blood tests and isolation period NOT required by UK authority

- **Other than registered equine animals**

- Blood tests required by UK authority :

- equine infectious anemia (within 30 days before the trip)

- Equine viral arteritis (within 21 days before the trip for male equidae not castrated aged of more than 180 days, unless they meet the vaccination requirements)

Period of isolation required by UK authorities :

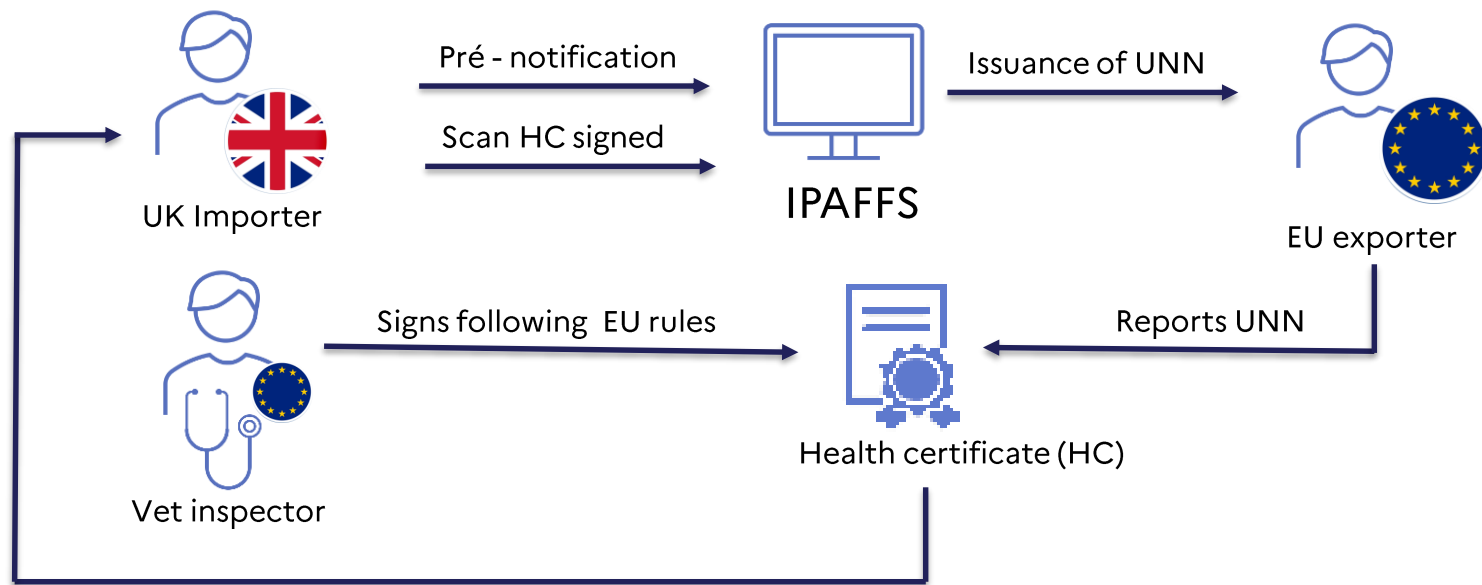
Other than registered equidae have to be isolated during **40 days** on a holding with a similar sanitary status before the transportation and separated from equids with different sanitary status during a minima **30 days**.

SPS Controls



SPS controls

1st january to march 2022:

- Equine entry will be possible at any point of entry into British territory.
- The documentary checks will be carried out online.
- Identity and physical checks may be carried out at the final place of arrival of equidae on the basis of a risk analysis.

From 1st march 2022:

Entry of equidae only in Border Control Point (BCP) with documentary, identity and physical checks on the basis of a risk analysis

Landbridge : What is needed to travel via GB from/to EU from/to IE

- Intra-trade animal health certificate – Traces
- No requirement to notify UK import system (Ipaffs)
- Notify UK via TRACES – Route
- Pre-notify EU BCP / TRACES NT

Transport Animal welfare

If you want to transport equidae from EU to GB or NI via GB, you will have to ask the British authorities to deliver you :

- Transporter authorisation (*UK version*)
- Certificat of competency (*UK version*)
- Vehicule approval (*UK version*)

EU versions of these documents will be accepted in NI, but not in GB.

In case of **not registered equidae** transport whose travel lasts **8 hours or more**, you will have to request two travel documents to cover the transport of equidae from the EU to or via Great Britain :

- A journey log approved by Animal and Plant Health Agency (APHA)
- Another journey log approved by EU Member State of origin.
